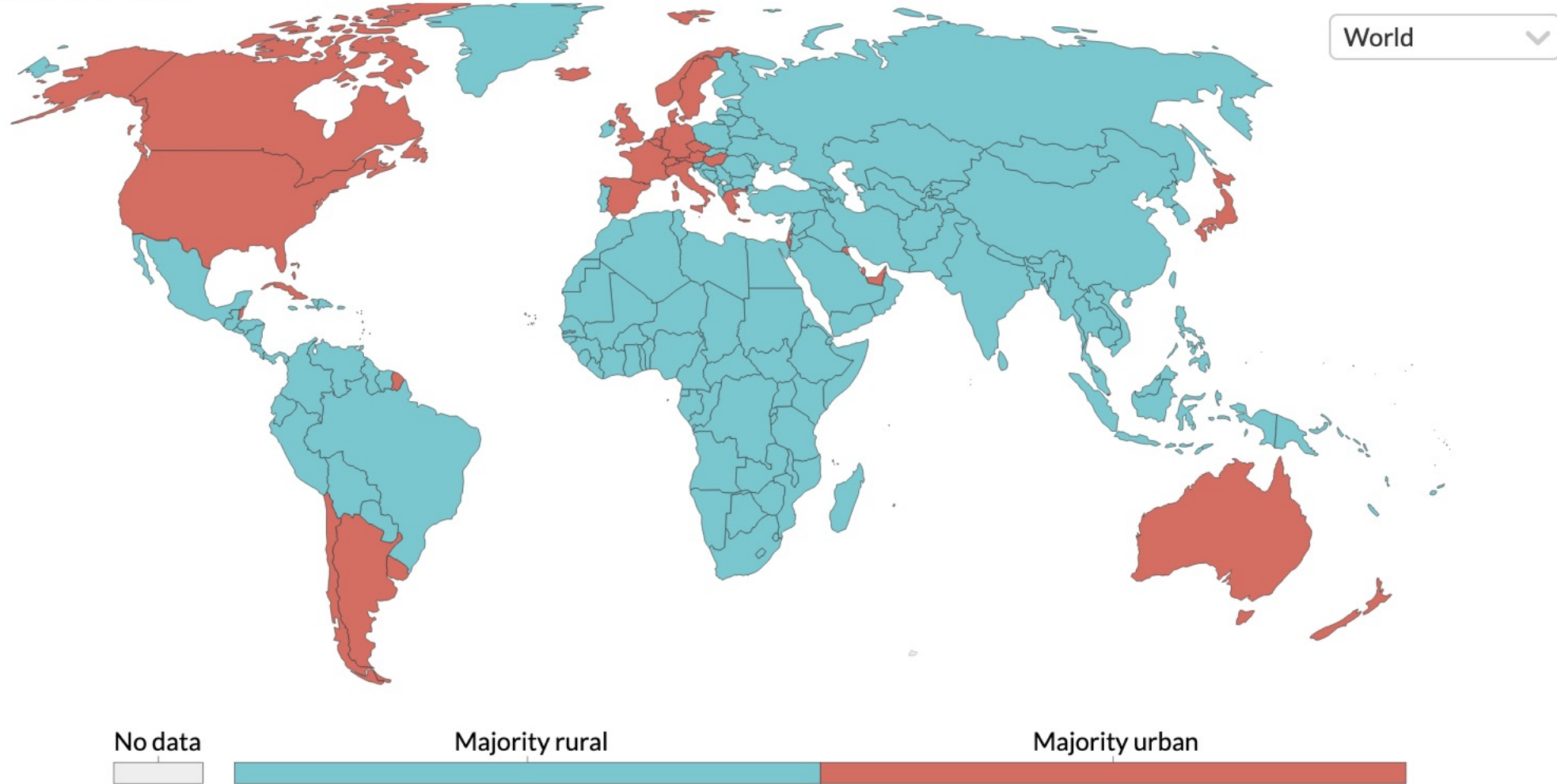


Do more people live in urban or rural areas?, 1950

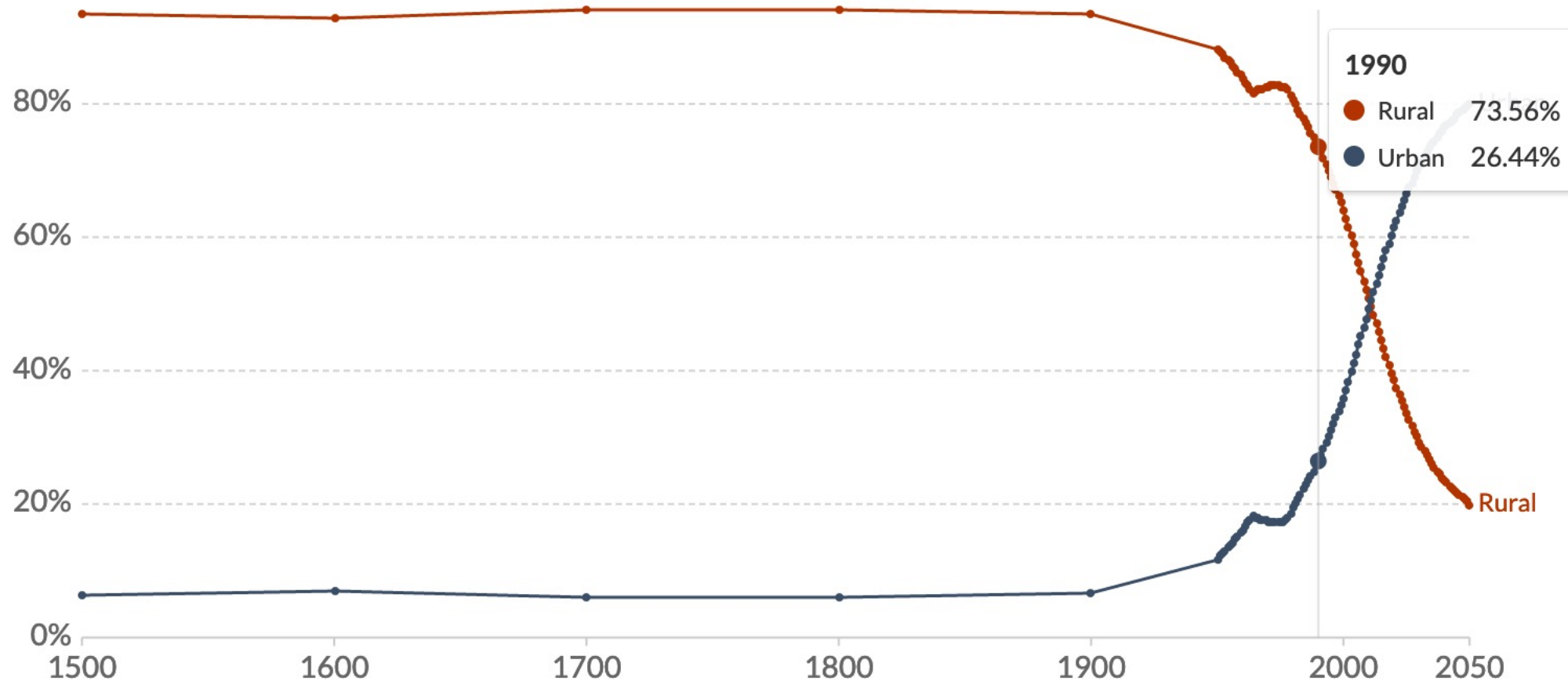


Do more people live in urban or rural areas?, China, 1500 to 2050

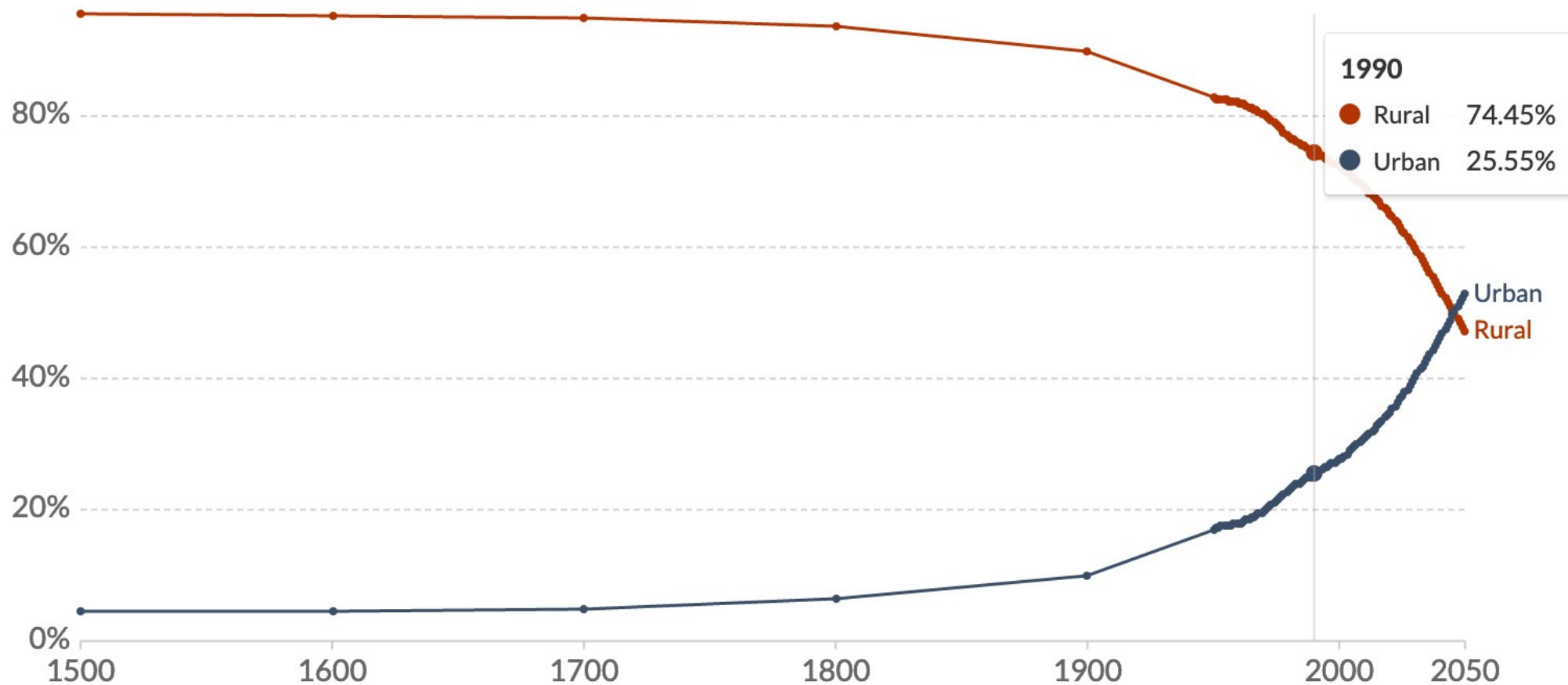


Do more people live in urban or rural areas?, India, 1500 to 2050

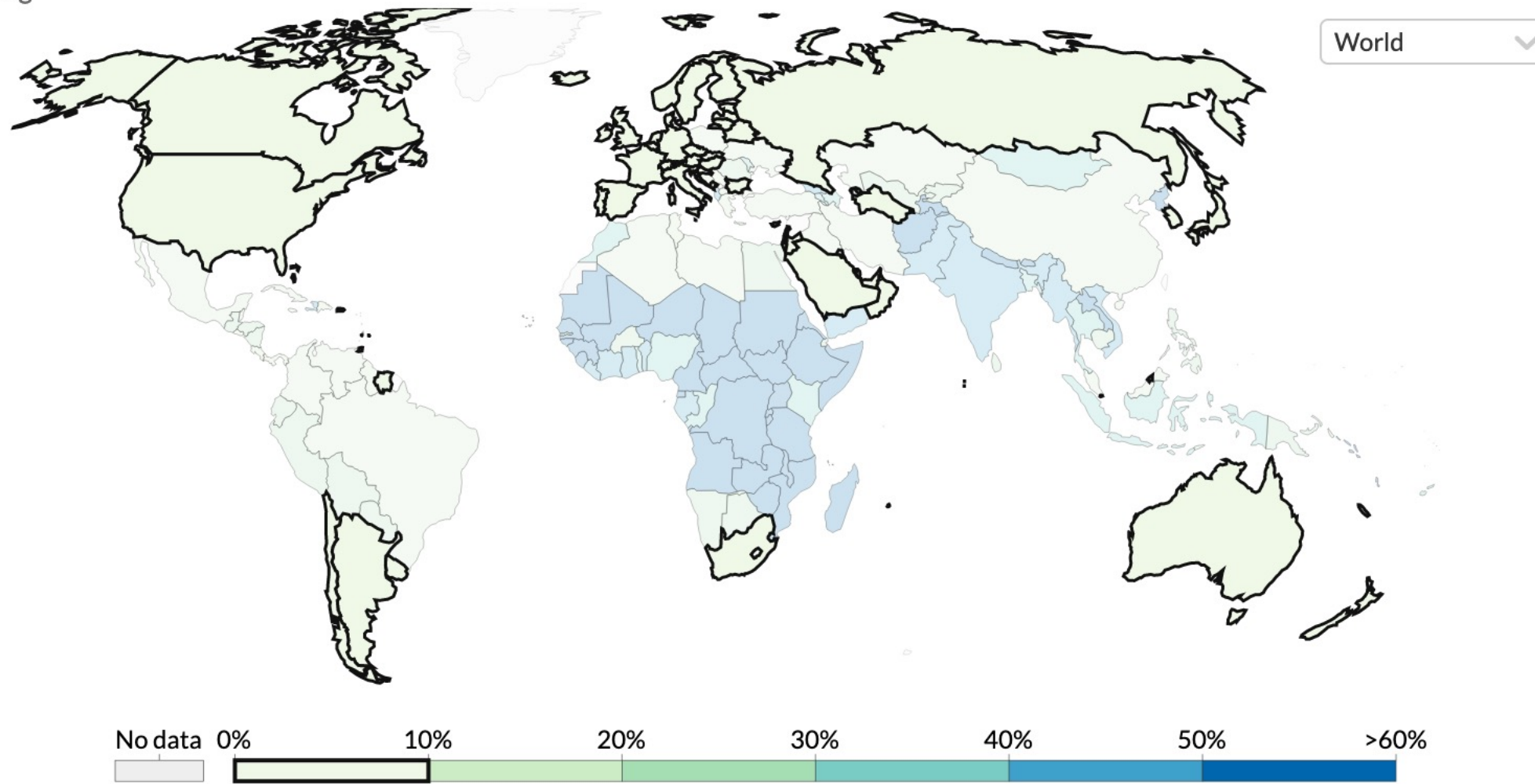

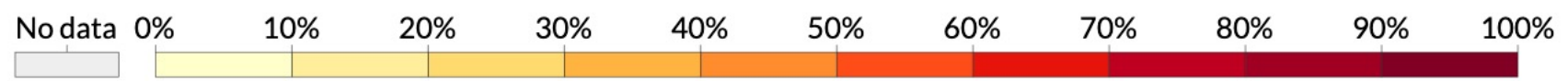
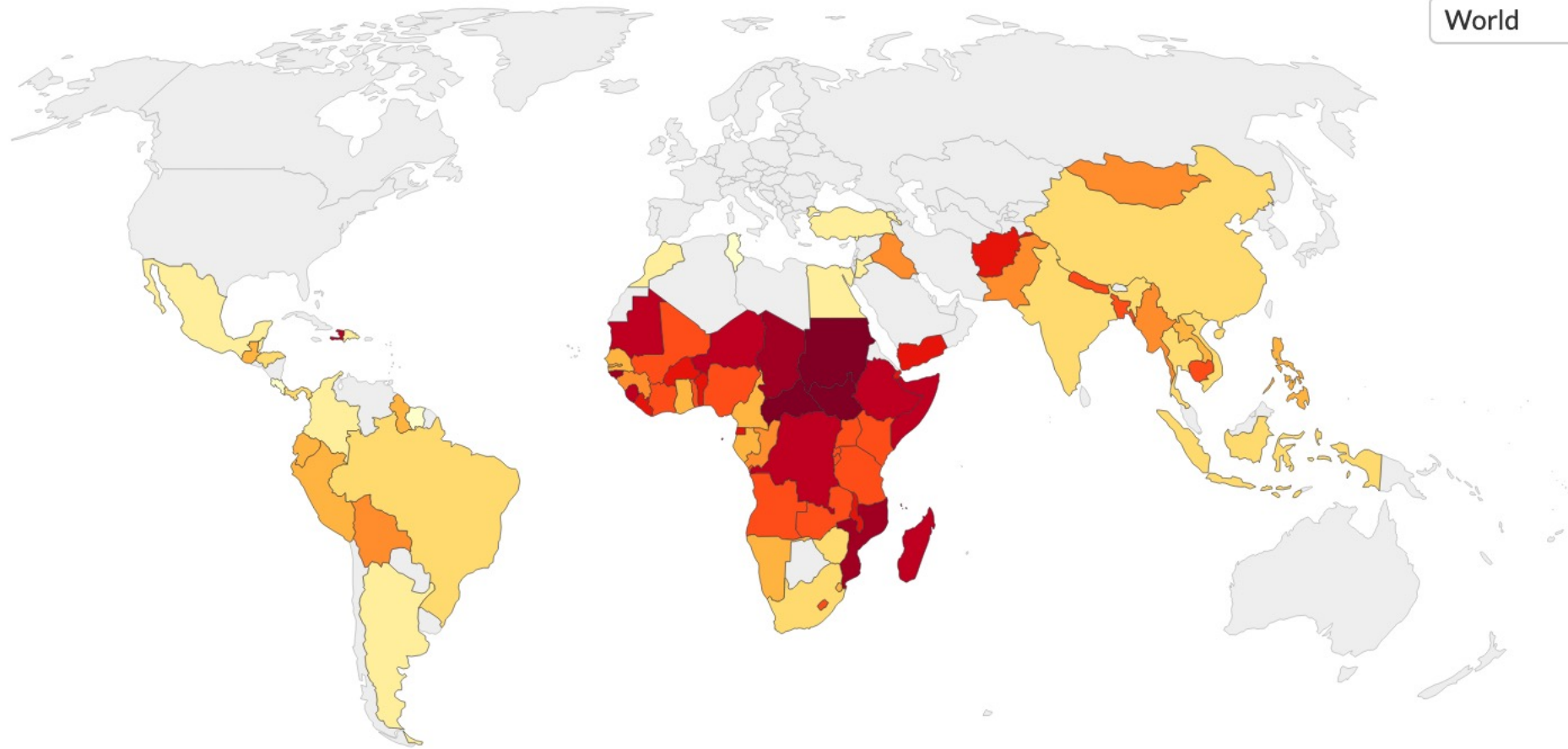
